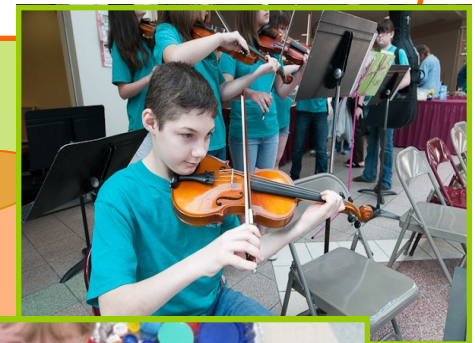

Why Teach Art?

The arts teach children to make good judgments about qualitative relationships. Unlike much of the curriculum which correct answers and rules prevail, in the arts it is judgment rather than rules that prevail.

What You Need To Know

You must be able to do the following to become a teaching artist with the BAC.

1. Understand your art form by being able to demonstrate, practice and verbally discuss the art.
2. Understand the classroom environment; pedagogy, human development. The BAC has developed a list of resources that you are encouraged to review, especially if you have no formal educational training.
3. Understand the collaborative process; working in an educational environment with a classroom teacher and possible school administrators.

Why Teach Art?

The arts teach children that problems can have more than one solution and that questions can have more than one answer.

The arts celebrate multiple perspectives. One of their large lessons is that there are many ways to see and interpret the world.
